

## Congregate Living Facility

Provides basic caregiving services primarily to vent and trach patients in a community setting of up to 10 patients. Payment for this service is exclusively via medical insurance. However, a request for waiver of this requirement may be filed through a Waiver Agency (insurance company or hospital), depending on whether the patient is contracted or not.

## Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

When patients need wheelchair and gurney-accessible transportation services to bring them to and from doctor's and dental appointments, dialysis treatments, chemotherapy and radiation treatments, outpatient physical and occupational therapy sessions, senior centers and adult day care, hospital discharges, admission to board and care facilities and even to run bank and grocery errands, this is the transport service for you.

## Life Coaching & Prayer Ward

Patients' medical treatments are best supported by non-medical or spiritual and/or mental reinforcements - with the ultimate goal of helping them get back a productive and healthy lifestyle, thus achieving a holistic well-being.

## Non-Medical Personal Home Care

This is for clients with active senior family members or wards with no existing medical needs but who deserve exceptional care in the comfort of their homes or receive the same individualized level of personal care in a carefully selected facility.

Services such as supervision in grooming, assistance in hygiene practices, medication reminders, feeding assistance, and running minor errands for your beloved seniors are yours to avail of.

## Specialized/Personalized Home Health Services

Some clients may prefer customized health services for their patients who need 24-hour, on-call staff assistance. These high-quality, safe and low-cost but nonetheless effective services such as in-home nursing, physical rehabilitation and other support services, may be made available right in the patients' home, while taking into account the clients' or their families' preferred time schedules.

The specific type and level of care for each client can be chosen from a selection of home health service packages.

## Palliative Care

When hospitalization is no longer deemed by doctors to be beneficial to a patient's medical treatment plan and the remaining objective is for the patient to be pain-free and comfortable within the family's warm circle of love - this is the family's best option.

This allows families to remain together while a team of skilled professionals ensures that all of the patient's concerns are closely monitored and attended to.

## Advanced Wound Care

Expert Mobile Wound Treatment (pressure ulcers, diabetic ulcers, sharp debridement, wound vac and ankle brachial index) and Gastric Feeding (replacement and maintenance) are brought right into the patient's home, in a board-and-care facility, or in a skilled nursing facility or even in hospitals at the patient's bedside - by a group of expert and dedicated surgeons, physicians and nursing practitioners.

Free wound care education for families, caregivers, nurses, and agencies and organizations are provided under special service programs as well.

## Caregiver Support

Basic caregiving services such as bathing, dressing, feeding, administering medications, grooming, toileting, reminding to stay active through light physical activities and helping with mobility, when needed, are delivered to individuals or groups based on a care plan from the client's attending physician/s.

## Board and Care Facilities

Helps families and/or guardians ensure that their loved ones' daily regimen of meals, medications, grooming, and hygiene needs and minor physical activities are supervised and seen to in a community setting of up to 6 residents.

Utilities, limited laundry service and cleaning of common areas are usually included in the service package of this type of facilities.

## Independent Living Facility

Compared to the community environment in a board-and-care facility, an independent living option allows 100% physically active and self-reliant seniors to retain their physical independence in a bigger community setting of up to 15 residents.

Said residents can come and go, to and from the facility at any time, but subject to the facility's monitoring requirements and under the supervision of a House Manager.
